## MEDICAL DOCTOR'S CERTIFICATION

The definition of a "Disabled Person" under the Public Housing Program follows:

A person who is under a disability as defined in Section 223 of the Social Act (42 U.S. C 423) or Section 102 (b) of the Developmental Disabilities and Facilities Construction Amendments of 1970 (42 U.S. C 6001 (7) Section 223 of the Social Security Act defines disability as:

- (A) Inability to engage in any substantial gainful activity by reason of any medically determinable physical or mental impairment which can be expected to result in death or which has lasted or can be expected to last for a continuous period of not less than 12 months; or
- (B) In the case of an individual who has attained the age of 55 and is blind (within the meaning of "blindness as defined in Section 416 (l) (1) of this title), inability by reason of such blindness to engage in substantial gainful activity requiring skills or abilities in which he has previously engaged with some regularity and over a substantial period of time.
- (C) Section 102(5) of the Developmental Disabilities Services and Facilities Construction Amendments of 1970 defines disability as a disability attributable to mental retardation, cerebral palsy, epilepsy or another neurological condition of any individual found by the Secretary (of Health Education and Welfare) to be closely related to mental retardation or to require treatment similar to that required for mentally retarded individuals which disability originates before such individual attains age 18, which has continued or can be expected to continue indefinitely, and which constitutes a substantial handicap to such individual.
