COMPLAINT FOR JURY TRIAL

Plaintiff, Clifford Ray Hackett, appearing pro se, states as follows:

I. JURISDICTION

1. This Court has jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. § 1331 (Federal Question) and 28 U.S.C. § 1332 (Diversity of Citizenship).

II. IDENTIFICATION OF DEFENDANT

2. The Defendant is currently identified as "Jane Doe," a female employee of Regal whose true name and address are unknown to Plaintiff at this time.

3. **REQUEST FOR DISCOVERY:** Plaintiff requests that the Court allow limited, expedited discovery, including but not limited to subpoenas directed at Regal, to identify the true name and contact information of the Defendant so that service of process may be completed.

III. STATEMENT OF CLAIM

4. Defendant advised and assisted in a crime against Plaintiff.

5. Defendant acted with the knowledge that said crime would cause significant harm and suffering to Plaintiff.
